



Year 1 students used their knowledge that they gained from their second unit, which was about creating a simple video game using the programme ‘Scratch’, to conduct Indirect Services. They aimed to help students with a learning disability or a difficulty in a certain subject overcome it. They designed and created simple educational games related to dyscalculia, dyslexia, dysgraphia, language difficulties, and ADHD. The students showed great and admirable dedication in understanding their target audience and then designing the game. Some designed for their younger siblings, others for their classmates, and some for general students who might need it. Several students shared their excitement about being able to help making learning more fun and attainable through their games.






